4. Qualifications for International Students

- (1) According to the Article 2 of "Regulations Governing Study by International Students in Taiwan", an international student shall be an individual whose nationality is not from the Republic of China as described in Article 2 of the Nationality Act* and also without overseas Chinese student status.
- * Note: According to Article 2 of the Nationality Law, a person who meets one of the following criteria acquires the nationality of the Republic of China:
- 1. A person whose father or mother was, at the time of his/her birth, a citizen of the Republic of China.
- 2. A person born after the death of his/her father or mother and whose father/mother was at the time of his/her death a citizen of the Republic of China.
- 3. A person born in the territory of the Republic of China and whose parents are both unknown or are stateless.
- 4. A naturalized person: the provisions specified in sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 of the preceding paragraphs shall apply to minors on the date of the promulgation of the amendment of this law.



4. Qualifications for International Students

- (2) Article 2 of "Regulations Governing Study by International Students in Taiwan also indicates that individuals with Republic of China nationality, having ceased to hold the nationality, are not qualified to apply for admission to a senior high school or university/college, if the period of the renunciation of the nationality is less than 8 years since the date, on which a revocation was issued from the Ministry of the Interior. According to the Cultural Exchange Agreement, a foreign national who was selected by a foreign government, organization, school, or educational/cultural group to study in Taiwan, is not subject to the limitation as prescribed in the preceding paragraph. The eight-year period as prescribed in the first paragraph shall be calculated from the date when the semester begins as set by each individual school. This regulation does not apply to students who are citizens of Hong Kong, Macau or the People's Republic of China.
- (3) International students who graduated from a high school, college or university recognized by the Ministry of Education in the Republic of China can apply for admission (please refer to the Website http://depart.moe.edu.tw/ED2500/Default.aspx for more information). International students with a high school diploma are eligible to apply for undergraduate programs; Bachelor's degree holders or with equivalent qualifications to that of Taiwan's academic degree system are eligible to apply for Master's programs.
- (4) Applicant has never studied in the Taiwan (R.O.C.) as an overseas Chinese student.
- (5) According to the Article 11 of "Regulations Governing Study by International Students in Taiwan", international students who drop out of or withdraw from university/college after admission may not thereafter apply again for admission under this regulation. The transfer of an international student to other schools shall be regulated and handled by rules of the individual institutions.



5. Scholarship

Level 1 scholarship (financially disadvantaged or outstanding)

US\$1,670 / NT\$50,000 per semester upon approval.

Level 2 scholarship (regular enrollment)

US\$840 / NT\$25,000 per semester upon approval.

- (4) One photocopy of the highest educational diploma (notarized copy of the translation in English or Chinese is necessary if the original diploma is not in English or Chinese).
- (5) Declaration of International Student.
- (6) Two letters of recommendation.
- (7) One copy of passport or other equivalent verification of nationality.
- (8) The original official transcript (notarized copy of the translation in English or Chinese is necessary if the original transcript is not in English or Chinese).
- (9) Financial certificate (At least US\$ 5,000,as a proof of adequate financial status for studying in Taiwan. The financial certificate must be verified by a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office. No verification is required if the document is issued by an organization or bank in Taiwan. Do not use intermediaries, company registrations, or individual certificates.).
- (10) The copy of the Chinese language proficiency test certificate of TOCEL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) A2 level and above, as well as CEFR (the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) A2 level and above; or can provide proof of a graduation certificate (or transcript) from a previous degree with a major in Chinese language and teaching predominantly in Chinese.
- (11) Additional required documents for individual programs.

- (1) The diploma submitted for application review shall first be authenticated in accordance with the rules promulgated by the Ministry of Education, Taiwan, ROC, except for diplomas issued by Overseas Taiwanese schools.
